BEHAVIOUR POLICY

POLICY STATEMENT:

Port Adelaide Caledonian Society Inc.(PACS) in pursuing its main objects as stated in the Constitution aims to improve the quality of life for the members, and regards exemplary conduct and behaviour, and the principles of fair play as essential to the attainment of maximum enjoyment from participation in all events staged by the Society. Accordingly, the PACS have developed Codes of Behaviour for Members, Parents, Spectators, and Teachers. These Codes of Behaviour are attached to and form part of this policy document.

CODES OF BEHAVIOUR FOR MEMBERS, PARENTS, SPECTATORS and TEACHERS:

The Codes of Behaviour for these participants focus on:

- Playing by the Rules
- Being a good sport
- Respecting the decisions of Officials
- The aspect of 'team'
- Respecting the rights of participants
- Removing all forms of bad behaviour
- Participating for enjoyment

CODES OF BEHAVIOUR FOR PARTICIPANTS:

The Codes of Behaviour for participants focus on:

- Respecting the rights and dignity of every participant
- Ensuring that participants are treated as individuals
- Ensuring a professional approach in providing a quality service to participants
- Ensuring operation within the Rules of the Sport
- Refraining from any form of abuse or harassment of participants
- Providing a safe environment for participants
- Providing a positive role model for participants

BREACHES OF THIS POLICY:

- All Members agree to adhere to the appropriate Code of Behaviour on payment of their membership fees each year.
- They acknowledge that the Society may take disciplinary action against them if they breach the Code of Behaviour. This includes any action by the Society deemed necessary under the Anti-harassment Policy – Policy No. 2.
- They acknowledge that the disciplinary action against them may include Expulsion of a member as per section 7 of the Constitution.

This Policy will be implemented and enforced as from 1 July 2012.
